

Questions To Promote Club



Clubs may submit announcements of events to be read to the school. Instead of just giving date, time and location, perhaps pose a teaser question which will be answered during the meeting.

For a session on the Sun ask “True or false? The core is the hottest part of the Sun and it gets cooler as you go out” (Answer false; the core is 16 million Kelvin, surface 5800, corona visible above surface during eclipses 1 million.)

For a session on the moon ask “How do scientists find the age of different features on the Moon?” (What’s on top of what, crater counts, samples returned to Earth, especially by Apollo astronauts).



For a session on comets ask : “Do comet tails follow the comet as it orbits the Sun?” (Answer no; the tail goes away from the Sun.).

The questions can also appear on posters which might be placed around the school.
